## The Dangers of Overdrafting

An overdraft occurs when you try to spend or withdraw more money than what you have available in your checking account. When your bank lets the transaction go through, your balance goes below zero, and that can come with expensive fees that you and your parents will not want to pay.

### How can you avoid overdrafts?

- 1. Review your balance before you spend
- 2. Set up banking alerts to let you know when your balance is low.
- 3. Leave a cushion in your account.

## **Navigating Your Debit Card**

- Card Number: A unique 16-digit number that identifies your card
- Cardholder Name: That's you! Your name is printed here so people know the card belongs to you.
- Expiration Date: Yes, even plastic has an expiration date! That's when your card will stop working. We will send you a replacement before that happens.
- **Security Chip:** Allows you to insert your card into a "reader" to make purchases while keeping your card secure.
- **Contactless Symbol:** This means you can tap to pay quickly when you check out at a store, restaurant, gas station, and more.
- Magnetic Stripe: You can still swipe to pay if chip or tap payments aren't available.
- CVV: A 3-digit code necessary for online purchases
